TRUMPING RULES

**USED TO DETERMINE PRIORITY WHEN A STATEMENT FALLS INTO TWO CODING CATEGORIES.*

E.G. CHILD – “I DREW A PRETTY PICTURE.”

PARENT – “YOU DID DRAW A PRETTY PICTURE.”

STATEMENT FALLS INTO BD, RF, AND LP CATEGORIES.

CODED AS LP BECAUSE LP TRUMPS RF AND BD

NEGATIVE TALK (NTA)

DIRECT COMMAND (DC)

INDIRECT COMMAND (IC)

LABELED PRAISE (LP)

UNLABELED PRAISE (UP)

QUESTION (Q)

REFLECTION (RF)

BEHAVIOR DESCRIPTION (BD)

TALK (TA)
